CARNEGIE-SCHADDE MEMORIAL PUBLIC LIBRARY/CITY OF BARABOO VOLUNTEER INFORMATION:

A volunteer is a person who performs tasks for the Carnegie-Schadde Memorial Public Library without wages, benefits, or compensation (including travel expenses) of any kind. Volunteers are recognized by the public as representatives of the library and shall be guided by the same work and behavior codes as employees. They work with the status of "at-will" employees. Volunteers may or may not be members of the Friends of the Carnegie-Schadde Memorial Public Library. The City of Baraboo does not provide workers compensation coverage for volunteers. The City requires negligence on the City's part for volunteers to collect on the City's self-insured liability overage. Only the volunteer's own auto coverage will cover auto claims. Minor children may only work as volunteers with the written consent of a parent or legal guardian.
