Summer Reading Program For All Ages


A Summer Reading Program for All Ages to Enjoy Together

For each completed row you will receive a raffle ticket to enter into a wide variety of prizes, from gift cards, local activities, electronics, toys, and much more! There will be something for everybody. Additionally, if you would prefer to just log reading time, you can fill out the other side instead. Readers can complete either (but not both) sides of the card to receive all opportunities for prizes.

Small prizes will also be awarded at completed rows along the way, with raffle tickets offered for each milestone.

Beastly Puzzles Book Walk

June 3-June 29

What animal can you create with no voice, leopard spots, false eyelashes, and some terribly stinky perfume? Test your animal knowledge by participating in our book walk and see if you can determine which animals are featured in the book pages throughout downtown Baraboo. Participants should stop in at the Youth Desk of the library to pick up their instruction packet and then return to the Youth Desk to pick up their prize. The book walk can be done individually or with a group, and it can be completed in one sitting or over the month of June. The book walk is intended for all ages.

Cardboard Canoe Races

Using only duct tape and cardboard, the library challenges your family to design, build, and race a cardboard canoe across the Campbell Park pool. All materials will be provided ahead of time and can be picked up at the library Youth Desk beginning June 12 through June 15. Bring your completed canoe to the pool on June 29 and see if you can make it across the pool. Registration is required. This program will run from 11:00 AM-12:30 PM on Saturday, June 29.

1000 Books Before Kindergarten

1000 Books Before Kindergarten is a free program that encourages caregivers to read 1000 books to a child before they start kindergarten. Stop in at the Youth circulation desk to register for the program, get your first tracking card and a free tote bag. Complete the program and get a certificate to a local bookstore.

You are your child's first teacher. Here are some tips for parents and caregivers:

Sing: Singing is a great way to learn language and it's fun. When we sing, the sounds that make up words become more evident.

Talk- Children listen to and learn the language they hear around them.

Read- Read everywhere and everything! Read books, signs, menus, etc.

Write: Scribble, draw, and make art together.

Play- Play is how children learn best.

Story and a Stroll
