Here are the most recent building projects in our system:

12/2008 Sequoya: New Library 20,000 sq. ft.

2009 Brodhead: New library 15,000 SF

2009 Lakeview Remodel/Addition 9,000 SF (6,800 remodel of existing space/2,200 new)

2011 Fitchburg: New Library 38,000 Sf

2011 WI Dells: Additon/remodel 14,000 sq. ft so now 22,636 sq. ft. (added a children's library, computer rooms, more meeting rooms, adult reading area and study rooms)

2012 Prairie du Sac: New building 13,490 sq. ft.

2013 Rosholt: New library 3,000 sq. ft.

2013 Pardeeville: Remodel (updating finishes, furniture and layout)

2013 Portage: Addition of 6,500 sq. ft.(children's library) now 24,500 sq. ft. and renovation of existing space

2013 MAD-CEN Renovation/Addition 125,000 sq. ft.

2014 Meadowridge Branch: Renovation/Addition (including a community room and commercial kitchen)

2014 Poynette: Addition 1,700 sq. ft.; now space 3,400 sq. ft. (new children's area)

2015 Cambridge: New Library 7,400 sq. ft.

2016 Marshfield New Library & Community Center--library 35,000 sq. ft.

Rome is currently adding approx. 3,000 sq. foot addition more than doubling their space and adding a community room they didn't have.

New Glarus is hoping to build a new 11,000-13,000 Sq. Ft. library in near future.

Oregon is beginning the process to build a new 35,000 sq. ft, library

Waunakee is also beginning the process for a new library that is 35,000 sq. ft.

Belleville is hoping to build a new 13,500 sq. ft library.

Deerfield is considering an addition to their library.
